Confidentiality is requested for all 26 power point slides prepared for a presentation entitled "QC Manufacturing, Inc. Overview - Prepared for Meeting with the CEC July 26, 2016." This presentation is referred to as the "information" below.

1(b). Specify the part(s) of the information or data for which you request confidential designation.

QC Manufacturing requests that all of the information provided be designated confidential.

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2. State and justify the length of time the Energy Commission should keep the information or data confidential.

The information should be designated confidential permanently. The information is a confidential settlement communication which contains confidential business information. Both settlement communications and confidential business information are entitled to protection under the Public Records Act.

- 3(a). State the provision(s) of the Public Records Act (Gov. Code, § 6250 et seq.) or other law that allows the Energy Commission to keep the information or data confidential, and explain why the provision(s) apply to that material.

The Energy Commission is entitled to keep the information confidential under several sections of the Public Records Act which include, but are not limited to, Government Code Section 6924 (b), 6924 (f), and 6924(k). Government Code Section 6924(k) incorporates the exemptions from disclosure found in the Evidence Code, such as exemptions for settlement communications and trade secrets.

- 3(b). Discuss the public interest in nondisclosure of the material submitted for a confidential designation. If the material contains trade secrets or its disclosure would otherwise cause loss of a competitive advantage, please state how it would be lost, the value of the information to the applicant and the ease or difficulty with which the information could be legitimately acquired or duplicated by others.

The information for which a designation of confidentiality is sought is being provided to the Energy Commission at the request of the Energy Commission staff. Granting the request is in the public interest since it will facilitate the exchange of information. QC Manufacturing, Inc. is not willing to make the information public since it contains trade secrets the release of which could harm its business interests and could not be legitimately obtained by others.

4. State whether the information or data can be disclosed if it is aggregated with other information or masked to conceal certain portions (including but not limited to the identity of the applicant). State the degree of aggregation or masking required. If the data cannot be disclosed even if aggregated or masked, explain why.

The information provided is not of a sort which can be aggregated with other information.

The information also cannot be effectively masked since the entire document is a settlement communication.

5. State how the material is kept confidential by the applicant and whether it has even been disclosed to a person other than an employee of the applicant. If it has, explain the circumstances under which disclosure occurred.

The information for which confidentiality is sought has been shared with counsel for QC Manufacturing, Inc.

At a meeting on July 26, 2016, after Energy Commission representatives indicated that the Energy Commission would consider the information confidential, the information was also shared with the Energy Commission.
