**RE: HUNTINGTON BEACH RETOOL PROJECT MITIGATION MAINTENANCE FUNDS: APPROVAL OF PROPOSAL TO ALLOCATE \$75,000 IN ACCORDANCE WITH COMMISSION CONDITION OF CERTIFICATION BIO-5 FOR THE HUNTINGTON BEACH WETLANDS RESTORATION PROJECT**

Dear Ms. McCarthy:

This letter approves your May 7, 2010 request to allocate \$75,000 for 2010 Annual Maintenance Budget, from the Huntington Beach Wetlands Conservancy Trust Fund for the Huntington Beach Wetlands Restoration project, which was established to restore the wetlands so that the health and biological productivity of aquatic coastal habitat will be increased. This fund was originally established in 2007 with \$5,372,745 in mitigation monies from AES Huntington Beach, LLC, as provided for in the California Energy Commission's Huntington Beach Decision (00-AFC-13) Condition of Certification BIO-5.


The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Energy Commission, AES Huntington Beach, and the Huntington Beach Wetlands Conservancy governs the process for the Conservancy to submit specific project proposals and requires Compliance Project Manager (CPM) approval of funding for the wetlands restoration project; no funds may be released without written approval of the CPM.

The approved funds for non-construction activities should remain with the approved fund administrator, Spectrum Asset Management, Inc., until such time as the funds are needed to pay invoices.
