Walnut Energy Center Authority (WECA), the owner/operator of the Walnut Energy Center (WEC) Project, has requested to correct a transcription error in Condition of Certification AQ-71. This condition provides emission limits during project commissioning.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

The Energy Commission staff reviewed the petition and finds that it complies with the requirements of Title 20, Section 1769(a) of the California Code of Regulations and recommends approval of WECA’s petition to modify the WEC Project and amend the related Conditions of Certification-Air Quality-71. Air Quality is the only technical area impacted by this petition.

COMMISSION FINDINGS

Based on staff’s analysis, the Commission concludes that the proposed changes will not result in any significant impact to public health and safety, or the environment. The Commission finds that:

- o The petition meets all the filing criteria of Title 20, section 1769(a) of the California Code of Regulations concerning post-certification project modifications.
- o The modification will not change the findings in the Commission’s Final Decision pursuant to Title 20, section 1755;
- o The project will remain in compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards, subject to the provisions of Public Resources Code section 25525;
- o The change will be beneficial to the project owner; and
- o The change is based on information that was not known to the parties during the time of certification because the owner learned of the transcription errors during commissioning activities.

RESOLUTION: APPROVAL OF ENERGYPRO VERSION 4.1

WHEREAS, EnergySoft, LLC. submitted an Alternative Calculation Method, called ENERGYPRO version 4.1 for the State Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission (Energy Commission) approval to replace ENERGYPRO version 4.0 that was found to have an error; and

WHEREAS, Energy Commission staff has determined that ENERGYPRO version 4.1 meets the requirements for approval of an Alternative Calculation Method as specified by the Low-Rise Residential Alternative Calculation Method Approval Manual, adopted by the Energy Commission November 5, 2003;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that on March 1, 2006, the Energy Commission approves ENERGYPRO version 4.1 for immediate use and decertifies all other versions of ENERGYPRO take effect on March 30, 2006 for use in demonstrating compliance for residential buildings with the *Building Energy Efficiency Standards*, which became effective on October 1, 2005.
