**COMMENTS:**

Dr. Doug Davy of CH2MHill spoke with Jeri Scott (Compliance Project Manager), Rick York, and Dorothy Torres of the Bio/Cultural Unit. Staff expressed concern that several locations of potential project impacts had not been surveyed for archaeological resources. Staff had previously asked for clarification in Data Requests, but the reasons the areas had not been surveyed were not sufficiently clarified in the responses. Staff explained that determining impacts was necessary prior to writing a complete project assessment. However, if it was impossible to survey a location, staff asked for specific information regarding the location(s) that could not be surveyed and specific information regarding the reasons a specific area could not be surveyed.

Dr. Davy said that he thought it would be possible to conduct additional surveys or to provide the information requested by staff before completion of staff's assessment.
