Amendment No. 2 is less than adequate and requires much more attention.
My comments are as follows:

0 Notification has not been adhered to as in required to in the CEC
Eastshore Energy Center 06-AFC-06 Evidentiary Hearing.

0 Excluded but not limited to East Bay Municipal Utility District, Alameda
County Water District, San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development
Commission (BCDC), State Water Resources Water Control Board, San
Francisco Bay. All of which have jurisdiction of the new laydown areas as
well as the site location.

0 The interconnect to the main gas line on Depot Rd. is less than ½ mile
from Chabot Los-Positas College as well as Hayward New Haven Schools.
They have note been noticed and should be and an emergency plan put into
place.

0 Transportation of both ground and aviation needs to be reviewed by staff
for because of the added laydown areas on Depot Rd., by bypassing Whitsel

RD. There have been new aviation accident findings and additional pilot incident reports on flying in and through power plant plumes. Aviation needs to be addressed.

0 Issues with Biological still remain open and continue to be an open issue.
