Subject: Docket #11-IEP-1E Transmission Planning

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is in response to Docket #11-IEP-1E. Although Riverside Public Utilities holds no direct ownership interests in bulk electric system facilities and does not produce a transmission expansion plan, it does hold long-term firm transmission service interests in the following paths and facilities:

1. Bidirectional service between the Intermountain Power Project and Mona Substation 345 kV transmission lines,
2. Bidirectional service between the Intermountain Power Project and Gonder Substation 230 kV transmission line,
3. Bidirectional service between the 500 kV Marketplace and Mead Substations,
4. Bidirectional service between the 500 kV Mead and Westwing Substations,
5. Bidirectional service between the midpoint of the 500 kV Lugo-Victorville transmission line and the 500 kV Adelanto Substation,
6. Unidirectional service from the midpoint of the 500 kV Lugo-Victorville transmission line to the 230 kV Vista Substation,
7. Unidirectional service from the Mead 230 kV Substation to the 230 kV Vista Substation, and
8. Unidirectional service from the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station 230 kV Substation to the 230 kV Vista Substation.

Riverside is a Participating Transmission Owner pursuant to the California Independent System Operator's Operating Agreement and Tariff. As such, operational control of the aforementioned transmission service interests was transferred to the California Independent System Operator effective January 1, 2003 following Riverside's execution of the ISO's Transmission Control Agreement.
