Please ask your data providers to round out any estimated numbers in their Demand Forecasts to a believable number of significant digits. When you prepare the CEC report follow the same principal.

When ever I or any practical entity sees an estimated number with 4,5 or 6 digits we immediately round it to more believable number. In past CEC reports the real significance of estimated numbers is hidden by unbelievable ending digits.. As an example estimated numbers 123456 Kwh and 123462 Kwh are taken as being different when in truth as estimated values they are exactly the same 123,000 Kwh..

Please make CEC reports more believable by r0unding out estimated numbers to believable ones.
