

**Bill Schooling, Department of Finance**

Bill Schooling is the Chief of the Demographic Research Unit in the California Department of Finance. Demographic Research is responsible for the state's population estimates, projections, school enrollment projections, and are the lead agency for the State Census Data Center.

Bill returned to Demographic Research last year after working as the State Demographer for Arizona. Bill began his career in the estimates program in Demographic Research and was asked to develop the State Census Data Center. He was elected as the first Chair of the U.S. State Data Center Steering Committee. Bill is the former chief of the population estimates program at the Census Bureau and the former manager of the Demand Analysis Office at the Energy Commission. Bill has a master's degree in public administration from USC and a master of science degree from Cornell's Population program in their Development Sociology School.
