I wonder if the value of this report is indicated by its listing of Edward Brown as Governor on the title page. I would like to see the wonderful crystal ball that the report authors use to generate future events. It must be a real wonder when it can predict 6 figure numbers for future electrical and gas consumption in the state.

I do not believe Edward Brown is the current Governor just as I do not believe the CEC crystal ball can predict the 6 figure numbers shown in the various tables. As I have written in the past three significant numbers is the maximum that I will believe for any future estimates of consumption.

As I have written in the past in planning for the future no utility can use anything but maximum predictions for future consumption. The low and intermediate numbers benefit only the CEC and are essentially useless.

I don't know who this report is intended for but I sure hope they read it with a good bit of skepticism.
