

Steve,

The Energy Commission is requesting an update to the S-1 form on capacity that you kindly provided early last year. The formal request was mailed out late yesterday in the attached letter from our Executive Director, B. B. Blevins. We are asking for this update by Friday, February 24, which is just 19 business days from today. We are only asking for an update to your load and resource estimates for the summer months of 2006: June through September. The S-1 form that you provided last year is also attached for your convenience, with a blue border around these months. Please highlight any changes to this form, such as the numbers in the columns for June-September 2006, or the rows that name individual supply resources. Please send this update to docket@energy.state.ca.us We are asking for this information only from the 13 municipal utilities who filed the S-1 form last year: Anaheim, Burbank, Glendale, Imperial ID, LADWP, Modesto ID, Pasadena, Redding, Riverside, Roseville, Silicon Valley Power, SMUD, and Turlock ID. The CPUC has directed the state's three large IOUs and five medium ESPs to provide resource adequacy filings by early February showing their expected supply resources for these same four summer months of 2006. Please feel free to contact me with any questions or comments. In the near future we plan to solicit feedback from information providers on this process that we initiated last year, including ways to better schedule and lighten the burden on power supply managers. Thank you again for your assistance and contributions.
