
Dear Ms. Lam:

Here in California an individual does not have to be licensed to perform a home inspection. There is no requirement that the home inspector be a licensed contractor. I think this is an excellent opportunity to mandate specific licenses, including passing mandatory State exams, for the different types of energy inspectors that are discussed in the Draft Proposed Regulation and Draft Technical Manual.
