On Tuesday, August 1, 2006 I spoke with Russell Brady, Contract Planner with Riverside County. Mr. Brady stated that the SVEP will not require a zone change from M-SC to M-H, as was stated in the County's July 20, 2006 letter on their Advisory Conditional Use Permit (CUP). Energy Commission staff will receive a revised letter from the County on the Advisory CUP stating that no zone change is required for the project. Additionally, according to Mr. Brady, the issue of the stack height will be addressed as part of the CUP. Staff expects little change in the conditions (as outlined in the July 20 letter), but the information in the cover letter, Attachment 1, and Exhibit A will change to reflect the County's decision to not require a zone change. At this time, staff does not know when we will receive the revision/final Advisory CUP.
