Description

On December 12, 2006 I performed a supplemental cultural resources inventory, at the request of Doug Davy/CH2M HILL, in support of the Sun Valley Energy Project. Specifically, I surveyed two additional transmission line alignments for tie-in to the Valley Substation, identified as Option 1 and Option 2 on the attached Figure 1. Both Option 1 and Option 2 alignments cross Matthews Road and connect to the Valley substation, approximately 600 feet and slightly northeast of the plant site. The project area is located in an unincorporated area of Riverside County, near the community of Romoland, California.

Using pedestrian transects spaced no more than 10 meters apart, I surveyed at least a 100-foot corridor for the Option 1 and Option 2 alignments. The Burlington Northern and Santa Fe (BNSF) railroad right-of-way paralleling Mathews Road was not part of the survey area.

Conditions

The area is dominated by agricultural land. Ground visibility was approximately 80%. The ground on the south side of Matthews Road falls within an active field and is heavily disturbed. Much of the ground surface north of Matthews Road has been heavily disturbed and the soil compacted. Bare spots were carefully examined for any signs of cultural material. Weather was sunny and warm.

Results

No cultural resources were encountered during the survey. Since no objects or sites were located, no site records were prepared. The segment of the BNSF Railroad paralleling Matthews Road was previously recorded and evaluated.


