Candace –

Sorry for the delay but attached is a list of storm related events occurring on Old Spanish Trail Highway. As I indicated in earlier emails, the County does not keep specific storm related data. As such, this information was gathered from our Road Department, using daily logs. Unfortunately, the manner in which the information is maintained does not allow for an easy determination what portion of Old Spanish Trail Highway was impacted by the noted event.

By way of explanation, the notation “no damage” means that a flood event occurred but the road did not suffer any damage. Where hours are listed, those numbers represent the number of hours expended by the Road Department to fix flood related damages. For instance, in 2012, there have been 6 flood events, with damages to the road requiring repairs on two occasions (July 16-23 and August 16).
