

NOTICE OF RECEIPT
PETITION TO AMEND
THE ENERGY COMMISSION DECISION for the
LARKSPUR ENERGY FACILITY PROJECT (01-EP-1C)



On April 9, 2007, Wildflower Energy LP, filed a petition with the California Energy Commission requesting to modify the Larkspur Energy Facility Project. The 94-megawatt (MW) project was certified by the Energy Commission on April 9, 2001, and began commercial operation on July 13, 2001. The facility is located in the Otay Mesa area of the City of San Diego in San Diego County at the intersection of Otay Mesa Road and Harvest Road.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED MODIFICATION

The modifications proposed in the petition would add one General Electric (GE) LM6000 combustion turbine generator (CTG) to the existing Larkspur Energy Facility which currently contains two GE LM6000 CTG units (Units 1 and 2). The proposed Unit 3 is a nominal 47 megawatt natural gas-fired simple-cycle unit that will be located immediately east and adjacent to Units 1 and 2. This will result in increasing the power generation capacity from 94 MW to a combined total of 141 MW. A 600 kilowatt natural gas-fired reciprocating engine will also be installed to provide black start capabilities. In addition, the project will require use of a temporary construction laydown area, including worker parking.

ENERGY COMMISSION REVIEW PROCEDURES

The purpose of the Energy Commission's review process is to assess the impacts of this proposal on environmental quality, public health and safety. The review process includes an evaluation of the consistency of the proposed changes with the Energy Commission's Decision and if the project, as modified, will remain in compliance with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards (Title 20, Calif. Code of Regulations, section 1769). The Siting Committee of two Commissioners will hold an Informational Hearing and Site Visit on June 29, 2007, details of which will be noticed separately. Energy Commission staff is currently reviewing the amendment request and will hold a public workshop and publish its assessment later this summer. The Siting Committee will conduct hearings and make a recommendation to the full Energy Commission as to whether the amendment should be approved or denied. A public hearing for the purpose of approving or denying the amendment proposal will subsequently be held at a regularly scheduled Energy Commission business meeting.

This Notice of Receipt is being mailed to interested parties and property owners within 1,000 feet of the project site who may want to participate in the amendment process.
