Mr. Garbett wanted to know what was up regarding the upcoming proceedings, and I explained, along with our rationale.

Initially, he seemed opposed, but at the end of our conversation he indicated that the conversion was a necessary step, and that his and other local folks opinion would probably prefer the 115 kV connection. He, as usual, ranged across an array of topics including PG&E, SVP, the City of San Jose, local politics, Metcalf, and the history and current status of Calpine.

His conversation was informative, enjoyable, but was not directly helpful regarding an opinion on the override. He seemed to be satisfied with my summary of why we were seeking to override LORS in this case..

He did leave me with a couple of interesting observations regarding LECEF 2 Phase 2:

The Metcalf plume-abatement system has recently failed badly and he wonders if the combined-cycle LECEF would make the same equipment/operator mistakes; May partially be attributed to operator/software, but also he heard it was a failure of materials (plastic) within the abatement system.

He felt that undergrounding the interconnections and doing away with the poles going towards the substation would have visual value.
