



Dear Mr. Shilling:

As a result of filing an application for a Small Power Plant Exemption on November 26, 2003, Kings River Conservation District deposited a total of \$192,000 to cover the estimated cost of the Energy Commission's environmental review of the Kings River Peaking Power Plant project. On May 19, 2004, the California Energy Commission approved the Kings River Conservation District's application for a Small Power Plant Exemption, 03-SPPE-02. We have completed our accounting of costs for reviewing the SPPE and have determined that a refund is due to the District. The following provides the breakdown of the CEQA reimbursable charges associated with the analysis necessary to issue the Mitigated Negative Declaration.
