Dear Ms. Kubick:

We note from your letter, dated July 1, 2005, that the location for the proposed San Francisco Electric Reliability Project has changed. However the stormwater and wastewater discharge requirements during construction, operation and maintenance of the facility remain unchanged from those outlined in our letter of June 30, 2004, to Mr. Hollenbacher.

We still recommend that you investigate the hydraulic capacities of the sewers into which wastewater will be discharged during operation and maintenance of the facility.
