REQUEST TO WITHDRAW FROM 04-AFC-1 PROCEEDINGS

Greenaction for Health and Environmental Justice respectfully requests to withdraw as an intervener from California Energy Commission proceedings 04-AFC-1. We do this regretfully since we represent a large number of low-income residents living in the 94124 and 94107 zip codes who will be affected by the siting of combustion turbines. We do this under protest for the following reasons:


- 1) Greenaction has been subjected to what we view as harassment and legal liability by CALIFORNIANS FOR RENEWABLE ENERGY, INC. (CARE). Their data request on June 10, 2005 appeared to us to be a calculated attempt to harass Greenaction and cause it financial harm by requesting information that was already available to CARE from the San Francisco Department of the Environment and;
- 2) There are inadequate checks and balances at the California Energy Commission to ensure that legitimate interveners are not exposed to legal and financial liability in their efforts to represent low-income residents in Commission proceedings. It is of grave concern to us that Commission resources such as "hardship relief" for interveners can be used to facilitate attacks on other participants in CEC proceedings.

We therefore regretfully resign as interveners from the proceedings and ask that the Commission notify us of this change in status.
