1. I asked Mary if she had received the PSA, and if she had a chance to review it yet. She said she had received it, but had not reviewed it. I said that the applicant wanted to know if the USFWS had any comments or concerns; if so, the applicant and CEC wanted to meet with her soon so any issues could be resolved before the end of November, which is when the FSA is scheduled for completion.
2. Mary said that as long as the USFWS had the opportunity to review the ERCs before the project came on line, then she didn't think they would have any problems with it.
3. I told Mary that we had noted in the PSA that the USFWS would require verification that the Emission Reduction Credits had been secured and surrendered before the SFERP project comes on line, and that the PSA specified the ERCs would occur in an area that would benefit the San Bruno Mountain Region. That seemed to be satisfactory to Mary, and she was not interested in a meeting.
