

RULING RE: SAN FRANCISCO POWER MOTION

I. BACKGROUND

On April 19, 2006, Intervenor San Francisco Community Power (SF Power) filed a Motion requesting leave to late file testimony associated with emission offsets and community mitigation funds. Intervenors Californians for Renewable Energy and Robert Sarvey each emailed statements that neither party had any objection to SF Power's request.

II. DISCUSSION

Testimony was due on April 17, 2006, except for responses to Staff's April 10, 2006 Supplemental Testimony on Waste Management and Soil and Water, which are due on May 1, 2006. SF Power does not indicate why it did not or could not meet the April 17 filing date. Rather, it bases its request on the assertions that it represents a significant number of project area businesses and residents, and that it has been actively involved with Applicant in designing a community benefits package.

We are loath to alter established filing dates, especially where doing so would result in unnecessary delay or possible prejudice to a party. In this instance, however, the late filed testimony relates to topics which will not be heard until the second set of evidentiary hearings on May 22 and 31, 2006. Furthermore, no party apparently objects to the request. Since other testimony for the second set of hearings is due on May 1, 2006, we will permit SF Power to also file its testimony on emission offsets and community mitigation by that same date.


III. RULING

SF Power's Motion is **GRANTED**. It shall file and serve its testimony, limited to those matters as described in the **MOTION**, no later than May 1, 2006.

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
