SAN FRANCISCO ELECTRIC RELIABILITY PROJECT FINAL STAFF ASSESSMENT WORKSHOP (04-AFC-1)

Purpose: California Energy Commission staff will hold a Final Staff Assessment (FSA) Workshop for the proposed San Francisco Electric Reliability Project (SFERP). The purpose of the workshop is to allow the City and County of San Francisco (CCSF), interested agencies, and the public to discuss the FSA published on February 17, 2006. The specific topics that may be discussed include: Air Quality, Hazardous Materials, Public Health, Soil and Water Resources, Waste Management, and Worker Safety and Fire Protection. 

Project Summary: On April 21, 2004, the Energy Commission determined that the SFERP Application for Certification (AFC) was data adequate, which was the starting point for the Energy Commission's licensing process. In November 2004, the CCSF filed a request to put the project on hold. On March 25, 2005, CCSF filed Supplement A to the application to change the location of the project. The CCSF initially planned to construct and operate a simple cycle power plant within Mirant Corporation's existing Potrero Power Plant property. Supplement A changed the project location to a 4-acre site owned by CCSF that lies south of 25th Street and approximately 900 feet east of Illinois Street. The new site is approximately 1/4 mile south of the Potrero site originally proposed. On December 20, 2005, the CCSF submitted another amendment to the project (Supplement B) involving a change in the recycled water supply source and related pipeline route, and a modification to the planned on-site tertiary water treatment facility.

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
