

Dear Ms. Leiba:

On November 17, 2006, the Starwood Power-Midway (Starwood) project filed an application for the confidential designation of a 5-Plex Residential Lease Letter, as part of the above referenced Application for Certification (AFC) with the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission).

On November 30, 2006, the Energy Commission sent a deficiency letter to Starwood stating that the materials, for which confidentiality was sought, had not been submitted with the application. On December 6, 2006, Starwood submitted additional materials to the Energy Commission.

On January 18, 2007, the Energy Commission notified Starwood that its application for confidentiality was still deficient since the Residential Lease Letter Attachment had not been included with the materials submitted on December 6, 2006. Starwood was advised that the deficiency needed to be corrected within 14 days. As of this date, Starwood has not corrected the deficiency. Accordingly, any materials that have been submitted regarding the 5-Plex Residential Lease Letter are available for public disclosure.
