

**SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION FOR THE STARWOOD POWER PROJECT,
APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATION (06-AFC-10)**

On November 17, 2006, Starwood Power–Midway, LLC, filed an Application for Certification (AFC) to construct and operate a 120 megawatt (MW) simple cycle power plant, the Starwood Power Project. The proposed facility would be located on 5.6 acres of land located within a 128-acre parcel in an unincorporated area of western Fresno County approximately 50 miles west of the city of Fresno and approximately 2 miles northeast of the intersection of West Panoche Road and Interstate 5.

A copy of the AFC was provided to your library in a previous mailing. Enclosed with this cover letter is a copy of the December 29, 2006, supplemental information to the AFC, which provides clarification to the original proposed project. Please file this supplement with the original AFC, along with the enclosed letter to the public.

Please make the enclosed AFC supplemental material available for those who may wish to be informed about the project. We request that you not allow the AFC, supplemental material, or any of its contents be removed from the library. To increase accessibility of the document, we ask, if possible, that you cross reference it as a general reference work under the title and author categories, as well as under such subjects as "Energy Commission," "electricity," "energy/generation," "power plant siting," or any other relevant subject.

**PUBLIC PARTICIPATION IN THE REVIEW OF THE STARWOOD POWER PROJECT,
APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATION (06-AFC-10)**

On November 17, 2006, Starwood Power–Midway, LLC, filed an Application for Certification (AFC) for its proposed Starwood Power Project, a 120 megawatt (MW) peaking power plant. The proposed facility would be located on 5.6 acres of land located within a 128-acre parcel approximately 50 miles west of the city of Fresno in an unincorporated area of western Fresno County. A copy of the AFC was previously provided to this library. Enclosed with this letter is a copy of a supplement to the AFC. On January 3, 2007, the California Energy Commission accepted the AFC with the supplemental information as complete. The Energy Commission staff has now begun the data discovery and analysis phases of the project's 12-month licensing process.

Energy Commission's Facility Certification Process

The Energy Commission is responsible for reviewing and ultimately approving or denying all applications for thermal electric power plants, 50 MW and greater, proposed for construction in California. The Energy Commission's facility certification process carefully examines public health and safety, environmental impacts, and engineering aspects of proposed power plants, and all related facilities such as electric transmission lines and natural gas pipelines. The Energy Commission is the lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act.

Public Participation

Over this coming year, the Energy Commission will conduct a number of public workshops and hearings on the proposal to determine whether the project should be approved for construction and operation and, if so, under what set of conditions. These workshops and hearings will provide the public and local, state, and federal agencies the opportunity to ask questions about and provide input on the proposed project. An Informational Hearing and Site Visit will be held in western Fresno County and will be noticed separately in the near future. The Energy Commission will issue notices for all workshops and hearings at least 10 days prior to the meeting.
