Purpose

The staff of the Energy Commission will conduct a Data Response and Issues Resolution Workshop for the proposed South Bay Replacement Project (SBRP). The workshop will describe the Energy Commission's Application for Certification (AFC) process and will provide an opportunity for the applicant, interested agencies, and the public to discuss data responses; i.e., Data Response Set 1-A, (submitted on November 29, 2006) and Data Response Set 1-B (submitted on February 14, 2007). An additional purpose of the workshop is to work toward resolving any outstanding project issues. Subjects to be discussed include: Air Quality, Public Health and Cultural Resources.

Background

On June 30, 2006, the AFC for the SBRP was submitted by the applicant to develop the SBRP as a natural gas-fired, combined-cycle power plant. The SBRP will be configured as two natural gas-fired combustion turbines with heat recovery steam generators (HRSG) and one steam turbine, and will have a nominal 500 megawatt (MW) output. The SBRP includes heat recovery steam generator (HRSG) duct firing which can raise the output up to an additional 120 MW for a maximum total capacity of 620 MW by boosting the output of the steam turbine.

The SBRP will be a replacement of the existing South Bay Power Plant (SBPP) that is owned by the San Diego Unified Port District (Port) and operated by the applicant under a Lease and Cooperation agreement with the Port. The proposed project site is immediately
