Purpose

The Energy Commission staff is analyzing the City of Vernon's Application for Certification (AFC) for the proposed development of the Vernon Power Plant project. Staff has served the applicant two sets of data requests dated December 15, 2006, and February 2, 2007; intervenor data requests were served on February 16, 2007. The staff workshop will focus on the applicant's responses to staff's and intervenor's data requests in the areas of air quality, public health, and environmental justice, and work toward resolving project issues. Other areas as necessary may be discussed. Before discussing individual technical areas, staff will explain the Energy Commission's permitting process. Following the workshop, staff will consider the comments it receives and will publish a Preliminary Staff Assessment containing its preliminary recommendations on the proposed project.

Background

On June 30, 2006, the City of Vernon, submitted an AFC to construct and operate a nominal 943-megawatt (MW) natural gas-fired combined cycle power plant, the Vernon Power Plant, in the City of Vernon. The proposed Vernon project site is located at the southeast corner of Fruitland and Boyle Avenues in the City of Vernon, Los Angeles County, in an area zoned for industrial uses. The proposed project site is a 13.7-acre portion of a 27-acre parcel that is currently being purchased the City of Vernon.


