

Dear Mr. Johnson:

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) appreciated the opportunity to have participated in the review of the Application for Certification the proposed Carlsbad Energy Center to be located adjacent to Interstate 5 (I-5) in Carlsbad. We have the following comments:

- The document should identify the Cooperating Agencies.
- On page 5.12-17, table 5.12-10 for I-5 northbound ramps/Cannon Road AM Peak Hour the existing delay and LOS are listed as 10.6 and B. Please correct this to 25.2 and C respectively. Please correct the future delay and LOS accordingly.
- On page 5.12-17, table 5.12-10 for I-5 northbound ramps/Cannon Road PM Peak Hour the existing delay and LOS are listed as 14.2 and B. Please correct this to 34.2 and C respectively. Please correct the future delay and LOS accordingly.
- On page 5.12-17, table 5.12-10 for I-5 southbound ramps/Cannon Road AM Peak Hour the existing delay and LOS are listed as 16.7 and B. Please correct this to 27.1 and C respectively. Please correct the future delay and LOS accordingly.
- On page 5.12-17, table 5.12-10 for I-5 southbound ramps/Cannon Road PM Peak Hour the existing delay and LOS are listed as 13.8 and B. Please correct this to 17.0 and B respectively. Please correct the future delay and LOS accordingly.
- Project should coordinate with Caltrans I-5 North Coast Corridor Project engineers to ensure adequate right-of-way. I-5 North Coast Corridor Project engineers have been in contact with Carlsbad Energy Center engineers to communicate any potential concerns, such as future build out of the Freeway Corridor. Please contact Fariborz Amiri at Caltrans District 11 Design Division for further coordination, (619)688-6963.
- All lighting (including reflected sunlight) within this project should be placed and/or shielded so as not to be hazardous to vehicles traveling on SR-94.

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
