Dear Commission,

This letter expressed my concerns for an additional power plant on the current site in Carlsbad, CA. We live in the condos directly across the lagoon from where the new plant would be located. I oppose the plant for the following reasons:

Health. My husband has chronic asthmas and is on advair twice a day as well as an inhaler. We already face increased pollutants from the expansion of the freeway, which will bring cars forty feet closer to our home. The additional power plant could bring additional problems to his health.

Visual impact on property value. When the balloons were in the air they were directly across the lagoon from our unit. The plant would be the main focus of our and view would be the first thing potential buyers would see. This could only have a negative effect and our property.

Noise. We will have the freeway 40 feet closer to us, and the there would have to be additional noise from the power plant machinery. We are less then 800 feet away.

Safety. The fact this would be a natural gas operation does cause concern. As you know a natural gas power plant in Middleton, Con, just blew up causing both death and injury.
