Since the year of 1952 the tall stack in the power plant has destroyed the coastal scenery in south Carlsbad. It was good news to me when I learned that this old power plant will be decommissioned in the near future. Our Carlsbad can regain its beautiful undisturbed coastal scenery. I envision that the stack and buildings in the plant can be cleaned up and turned into a shopping heaven, just like the canaries in Monterey.

It was shocking to me that two new power plants could be built adjacent to the existing plant. This means that the south Carlsbad down town coastal line will be disrupted by a larger group of concrete buildings and more smoke stacks than the existing plant. The hope of having more tourists visiting the south Carlsbad down town will diminish because such a large power plant complex will detour the tourists from coming to Carlsbad down town. As a small business owner I depend heavily on tourists. Without tourists my business will not survive.

The impact from the new power plants on me will be three folds: on my health, my business, and my home value. I can foresee that in the future many small business owners will sell their businesses and struggle to survive on their reverse mortgage.

At this moment I am too depressed to think of any technical aspects of the power plants, existing or proposed. After three days of listening to the hearing I believe you are in control. I am impressed by the effort that all parties put in this hearing. All the effort would not be wasted if the proposed site were moved to few miles inland.

Mr. Boyd and Mr. Kramer please spare the Carlsbad coastal region and let us welcome the tourists into our downtown. I appreciate your generosity greatly. Thank you for working for long hours on this hearing. Carlsbad residents do not mean to offend you and your staff in any way. We are desperate.
