Please say **NO** to NRG proposed new power plant in Carlsbad.

Why would the citizens/tax payers of California want a new power plant built on a heavily congested traffic corridor between Los Angeles and San Diego? With the proposed site situated between the I-5 Freeway and the train tracks, it's an accident waiting to happen.

Since new power plants are no longer cooled by water, there's no need to build a plant at the Coast. Build it inland in a non-residential area.

The infrastructure currently in use with the old power plant is outdated - it's been there since the 1950s. The new power plant will need new infrastructure. It's easier and more cost effective to build from scratch than trying to update an antiquated infrastructure
