Please say NO to NRG proposed new power plant in Carlsbad.

Why would the citizens/tax payers of California want a new power plant built on a heavily congested traffic corridor between Los Angeles and San Diego. With the proposed site situated between the I-5 Freeway and the train tracks, it's an accident waiting to happen.

Since new power plants are no longer cooled by water, there's no need to build a plant at the Coast. Build it inland in a non-residential area.
