I am writing to you to indicate that as a resident of Carlsbad, I am against NRG building another power plant at the existing location on Encinas avenue in Carlsbad.

There are many other places better suited to building a power plant, and it makes no sense to put it on prime beachfront property, since the new types of power plants dont need seawater for cooling anymore.

NRG has used that area for about 50 years already. Enough is enough, no new plant, and tear the old plant to the ground. The City of Carlsbad has even volunteered to allow for a new plant location in the inland section of the city, away from the beach, the freeway, the railroad tracks, etc. There is an industrial area available north of Palmar Blvd, east of El Camino.
