This email is for the California Energy Commission in regard to public comments on the preliminary decision to build a new power plant in Carlsbad, California, next to the current power plant location at Cannon Road/Carlsbad Blvd/Interstate 5.

For the record, I am opposed to the building of a new power plant at this location. I have been a resident and home owner since 1987 in the Terramar community which is right across the street from the existing power plant. I understand that when the existing power plant was built, this location was chosen because of the need for access to ocean water to help in the processing of energy. As it has been explained to me and my neighbors, access to the ocean water is no longer a necessity and would not be needed for the current technology used. In addition, the new power plant's proximity to Interstate 5 could create safety issues for traffic flow and for our fire department. This ocean front land should not be used for a power plant or for any industrial facility. The current power plant has been an eye sore for 50 years. There are numerous choices for other profit making uses that would be pleasing to the eye and would enhance the beauty of our beach community. Please do not continue to pave over our paradise.
