

subsequently issued on March 28, 2012. The ruling did allow the parties to respond to the Staff Memorandum by April 2, 2012 after the new PMPD was issued. This provided a window of twelve days to respond to the Staff Memorandum and any PMPD issues that incorporated the Staff Memorandum's arguments.

The Center plans to respond to the Staff Memorandum to the extent that it is addressed in the PMPD. However, since the PMPD has been released, a response to parts of Staff's Memorandum that was not incorporated into the new PMPD would be an unnecessary academic exercise. Furthermore, the Notice of Availability of the Revised Presiding Member's Proposed Decision requests that parties provide comments on or before April 17th, 2012, and the final due date for comments on the PMPD is April 27, 2012. Since any relevant response to the Staff Memorandum will be incorporated into the Center's response to the PMPD, the Center hereby gives notice that it will not file a specific reply to the Staff Memorandum by April 2nd. The Center will file timely comments on the PMPD.
