Dear Mr. Arellano,

This e-mail is in response to your e-mail sent to Shaelyn Strattan dated November 6, 2008. In your e-mail, you asked that the California Energy Commission's main webpage for the KRCD Community Power Plant include the facts that the Indianola Elementary School is about 50 yards from the proposed site and a middle school (Abraham Lincoln) is about 200 yards away.

In responding to your e-mail, I reviewed cartography information showing the actual distances for these school sites to the proposed plant site. According to the information I reviewed, the proposed plant is .65 miles (1,144 yards) from Indianola Elementary School and 1.85 miles (3,256 yards) from Abraham Lincoln Middle School.

Please let me know if you think that the information I provided regarding the distances is not accurate. Additionally, if you are interested in formally participating in the licensing process of the KRCD Community Power Plant, you may do so by contacting the Commission's Public Adviser's Office. You can contact them at (800) 822-6228 or by e-mail at publicadviser@energy.state.ca.us.

In addition, I encourage you to review and comment on the Energy Commission staff's draft analysis of the project when it is published. The draft analysis is called the Preliminary Staff Assessment (PSA). I also encourage you to attend the public workshop for this project. This workshop will be held in a location near the project area.

The PSA should be published in the early part of 2009.
