**Comments:**

Staff called the San Luis Obispo Planning and Building Department and left a message in regards to school impact fees. Michelle Werling, Construction Permit Technician for San Luis Obispo County, returned staff's call. Ms. Werling informed staff via voicemail that the school impact fee is usually applied only to buildings that could be occupied by people. Staff called Ms. Werling back and spoke with her directly. Ms. Werling informed staff that San Luis Obispo County has not applied the fee to solar projects in the past. San Luis Obispo County only applies the school impact fees to livable buildings or structures than can be occupied by persons. Additionally, Ms. Werling told staff that by the County's definition the proposed solar farm would not be subject to the school impact fee.
