SUBJECT: Traffic Safety on SR-58			

Staff spoke with Officer Tammi Reece from the California Highway Patrol (CHP) office in Templeton, CA. Officer Reece informed staff that State Route 58 (SR-58) from US 101 to California Valley is under the jurisdiction of the CHP Templeton office and SR-58 from California Valley to I-5 is under the jurisdiction of the CHP Buttonwillow office.

Officer Reece informed staff that very few traffic collisions have occurred along the portion of SR-58 that is patrolled by Templeton officers.

When staff informed Officer Reece that the proposed project would require up to 150 truck trips to the site per day, she indicated that hiring CHP Commercial Officers to patrol SR-58 daily throughout the duration of project construction would be an effective measure to encourage traffic safety. Additionally, Officer Reece stated that the use of CHP escorts would likely be required for oversize loads that travel along Bitterwater Road.
