Staff spoke with Julie Meyers, a Civil Engineer Technician at the San Luis Obispo County Department of Public Works to discuss roadway geometrics and other data for Bitterwater Road.

Ms. Meyers informed staff that Bitterwater Road is paved and had an Average Daily Traffic (ADT) volume of 48 vehicles in 2007. She also informed staff that the county maintains a bridge along Bitterwater Road just south of State Route 46. This bridge is rated at 60,000 pounds, therefore travel over the bridge is restricted to vehicles that weigh 60,000 or less.

This information was verified in an e-mail sent by Ms. Meyers on July 18, 2008 (attached).





1) Intersection Hwy 46 & Bitterwater
