

Staff spoke with Manuel Fonseca in the Caltrans Legal Truck Size & Weight Work Group regarding truck travel on State Route 58 (SR58). Mr. Fonseca confirmed that SR58 is designated as "Advisory" for truck traffic. Specifically, the advisory restricts travel to trucks with kingpin-to-rear axle (KPRA) distance to less than 30 feet, with a maximum truck length of 65 feet, (i.e. the distance between the rear axle of the trailer and the point at which the trailer connects to the back of the semi tractor).

Mr. Fonseca indicated that trucks with KPRA of 30 feet or more may have difficulty passing certain roadway geometrics such as sharp turns and would receive a ticket from California Highway Patrol if caught traveling SR58.

Mr. Fonseca also indicated that it is possible to request the local Caltrans District (District 5) to upgrade SR58 to a Terminal Access route to accommodate larger trucks, which would require preparation of a detailed engineering analysis to determine whether or not an upgrade is possible and what improvements would be necessary to do so.
