<b>SUBJECT:</b>	Emergency Response at the CESF Site		

Staff spoke with Mr. Chad Zrelak, a fire captain at the CalFire/San Luis Obispo (SLO) County Fire Department. Mr. Zrelak informed staff of the following:

- SLO County contracts with the California Department of Forestry to provide fire protection to SLO County
- CalFire/SLO County Fire Department is the responding agency for emergencies in SLO County and the CESF site
- Station #42, the Carrizo Plain Fire Station would be the primary responder for an emergency at the CESF site
- Station #42 is located at 13050 Soda Lake Road approximately 3.5 miles southeast of the CESF site
- If necessary, emergency response at the CESF site would be supported by the Shandon Fire Station (Station #31) located at 501 Centre Street Shandon, CA 93441 and the La Panza Fire Station (Station #41) located at 5398 Pozo Road, Santa Margarita, CA 93453

Fire fighting and emergency equipment at the responding stations include:

**Station #42 Carrizo Plain Fire Station**


one (1) state fire engine, one (1) rescue squad vehicle

**Station #31, Shanda Fire Station**

two (2) fire engines (1 state, 1 county)

**Station #41 Lapanza Fire Station**

one (1) state fire engine



**Note:** State engines are primarily designed for wildland fire fighting. County engines are designed for multi-use municipal and wildland fire fighting.
