SUBJECT: Carrizo Project Native American Concerns		
<p>Staff responded to Mr. Burch's call. He said that the Carrizo project area was a sacred area. In a previous conversation Mr. Burch had explained that the Carrizo area was important in Salinan tribe oral tradition. He also said that an enrolled Salinan tribal member lives adjacent to the proposed project location.</p> <p>Mr. Burch also expressed his concern that Native people are still here, but instead of living on tribal lands, they live in modern communities. He would like the opportunity for qualified Native Americans to be able to apply for jobs with the Carrizo Project. He felt that it was particularly appropriate for Native Americans to be involved with an alternative energy project.</p> <p>Mr. Burch had previously spoken with Perry Fontana of Ausra to discuss a proposed tour of the project location. Mr. Burch and Gary Pierce, Contemporary Council Lead are both waiting for Mr. Fontana to contact them regarding final arrangements for a tour of the project location.</p>
