**Michael Strobridge** requests that you answer the following data request within 30 days. All the information sought is relevant to the proceeding and is in the control of the applicant and not readily available from other sources. In answering this data request, you are required to furnish full and complete answers.

It appears that URS/ Ausra has left out all concrete activity in the Lay Down Area. The Carrizo Construction Water Estimate Chart states under Concrete Hydration that 75,000cy of concrete will be poured in the power block and the solar field but does not include anything in the Lay Down Area. The extensive pouring of concrete will have a large impact on estimated traffic conditions due to the need for extra concrete trucks and personnel, also the initial water estimates are in inaccurate without knowing how much concrete will be poured in the Lay Down Area.

1. Explain how many cubic yards of concrete will be needed to pour the foundation for the 40,000sq ft Manufacturing building located in the Lay Down area. I am asking this because pouring concrete will affect water supplies for me and my neighbors.
2. Explain how many cubic yards of concrete will be needed for the Fueling Station located on the Lay Down Area.
3. Explain how many cubic yards of concrete will be needed for the site offices in the Lay Down Area.

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4. Explain how many cubic yard of concrete will be needed for the steel storage building/pad in the Lay Down Area.
5. Explain how many cubic yards of concrete will be needed for the mirror storage building/pad in the Lay Down Area.
6. Explain how many yards of concrete are needed in the equipment storage buildings/pads.
