



**PROPOSED NEW POWER PLANT, ANAHEIM, COUNTY OF ORANGE**

Dear Joe Ocampo,

Your name was provided to the California Energy Commission by the Native American Heritage Commission as a representative of a Native American community who might be interested in the proposed construction and operation of a natural-gas-fired power plant in northeastern Anaheim, in Orange County (see attached map).

The Energy Commission has jurisdiction over the proposed project and has received an application for a permit to build and operate the power plant, known as the Canyon Power Plant. You will receive, if you have not already received, specific information about the proposed power plant from the project applicant. 



- Sewer Line




PROJECT SITE
