PROPOSED NEW POWER PLANT NEAR THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

The California Energy Commission has received an application for a permit to replace a co-generating unit and to add an additional generating unit in the existing Chevron Richmond Refinery, near the City of Richmond, in Contra Costa County. The project site is located at the following latitude and longitude: 37° 56' 27.69" N, 122° 23' 22.44" W. Township and Range data are not available, as this area was part of a Mexican land grant.
