The Committee's November 15, 2007 order granting the motion for stay or suspension requires that Chevron Richmond Refinery submit a status report to the Committee every sixty (60) days. This status report represents the first status report.

At this time, Chevron Richmond Refinery is working with the City of Richmond to address comments received on the Renewal Project Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and anticipates that the City might issue a Final EIR in the timeframe of March, 2008, however the actual schedule for the remaining review and comment processes for the EIR has not been finalized. Chevron does not have an expected restart date for the Small Power Plant Exemption Application process at this time.


